application rates and guidelines

Aquasap can be used as a seed soak, a root drench, in fertigation systems and in foliar sprays.

Soak seeds or drench seedling roots before planting at 0.02-0.04% with adequate water. In fertigation, apply every 3-4 weeks at a rate of 200g/100 L tank per acre. As a foliar on vegetables, apply 250-350g every 10-14 days. As a foliar on field crops, apply 200g at key growth stages.
